CALL TO ORDER

OLD BUSINESS

Discussion regarding the Provincial Numeracy and Literacy Assessment. No additional information provided by Ministry at this time. The Board Chair will inquire regarding Numeracy and Literacy Assessment with Ministry Partners on October 25, 2017 and may be able to provide some clarification.

A KTTA Rep asked about the wording of FSA communication to teachers. A Management Rep read the enclosed information received in an email from the Director of Instruction after discussion with two District Principals and a Vice Principal. A condensed version of their conversation follows:

"This has come up in the past. There is no pre-marking request from the NFRA.

There technically isn't any pre-marking for the FSA either. However, because we do provincial exemplars, we have asked in the past if teachers could put a sticky note on the booklet if they 'think' it might be a 1 or 4. It just makes it simpler for the staff that pull exemplars to find those booklets so they don't have to read through EVERY booklet. This of course has only been an "ask". Teachers are not required to do so. Some do and some don't depending on the environment. There is no requirement to do this. Some teachers help and others choose not to -- we do not require teachers to help."

if a specific school needs further instruction the Management Rep will discuss with Director of Instruction to send out further clarification. A KTTA Rep felt message was not received at all locations and sought further communication on the matter with teachers.


